

## **The Movement Library is now 'Mobile'**

The Movement Library is now available for use on mobile devices such as tablets and some smartphones. This will allow practitioners to have the video clips available to them wherever they are teaching and coaching. The compatible devices include those using the Apple iOS platforms; Android based devices and the Microsoft Surface RT platform. For those smartphones that are of a certain age where downloading is not available then the video clips can be accessed via streaming (ensure that you do not exceed your data download package with your service provider).

### **Purchasing**

The purchase process has not changed and all the information is available on the website FAQ page where the entire process of purchase, installation and license management is displayed. The licenses are for one year for one device and the details of the size of each component you are downloading are displayed on each individual PRODUCT page on the website.

### **Changing Devices**

Those customers who have purchased video clips for the laptop (PC and Mac varieties) can change their license to their mobile device. Current customers can already manage and renew their licenses by using the systems available on their personal section of the website.

Log in to the website using your original username and password created at the original point of purchase.

Go to SUMMARY where you can see your licenses and the expiry date and location for each of them. (This SUMMARY section is also the place to go when renewing the license.)

Go to USERS where you will see where each of the licenses is linked to the Mac address of the device you are using.

DELETE the link to the device which will free up the license for use on the new device.

Follow the full installation as before – choosing the Player version you require from the list available - and ***ensure that a new 'Registered by' name is entered.***
